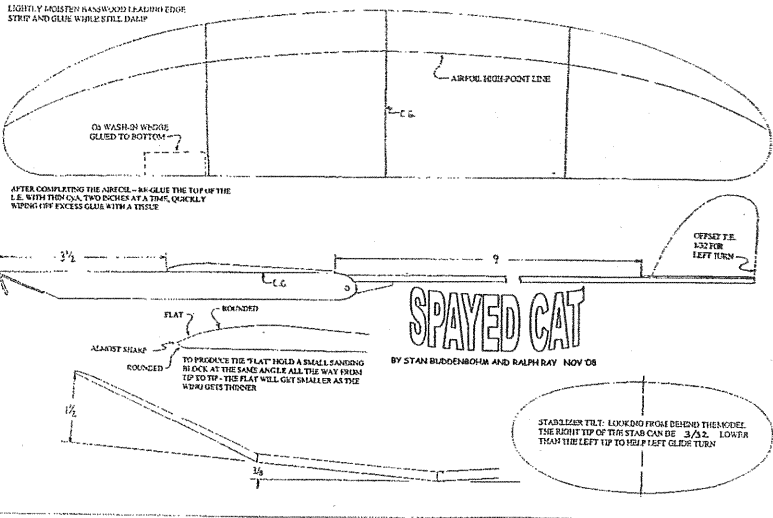


I have two new catapults to offer – SPAYED CAT and CURIOUS CAT 24

SPAYED CAT is a 16" span model with a longish tail moment of 9". This cat might be the best yet! SPAYED CAT employs a new launching method. The hook is on the nose near the top of the fuselage and you hold the model under the LE of the wing. The geometry of the hook and hold positions allows the stab to miss your fingers as it whizzes by. Some practice is required but I have never hit the stab. Hold the grip between your thumb and forefinger with the rest of your fingers curled into your palm. The greater rubber stretch (because your fingers are closer to the hook) means higher launches. Also there is less drag with this method and the model ends up lighter with no grip at the back!

SPAYED CAT is the only kit that comes with the new fuselage but CURIOUS CAT 24 uses the same style of hook and grip – with the old style of fuselage. It accomplishes this by raising the tail to get out of the way of your fingers. CURIOUS CAT 24 may look out of the ordinary (that's not bad is it?) but it maxed out and won its first contest against some top flyers like Lee Hines.
